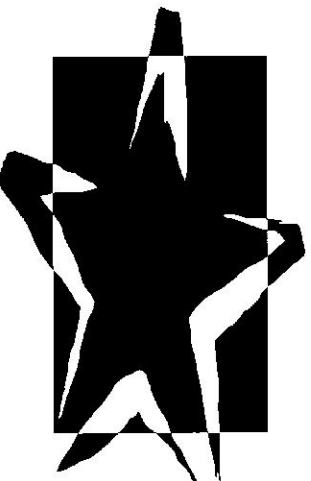

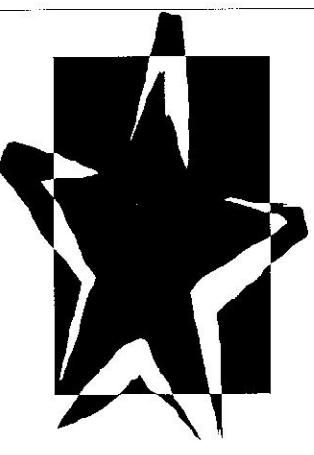

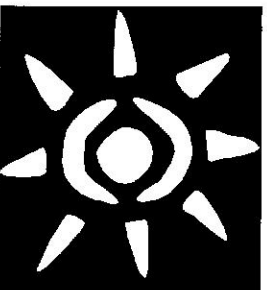
Late Clinic

Walk-ins are welcome, although some services require an appointment.

Interpreters are available - you are not required to provide your own.



Fees

- Some services are free.
- Some services are based on a person's income (sliding fee scale).
- Medicaid is accepted for some services.
- No one will be refused services because of inability to pay.
- Arrangements can be made for payment.

Environmental Services

- Investigation and inspection of septic system installation.
- Investigation of nuisance complaints concerning public health.
- Inspection and regulation of food service establishments.
- Education for food handlers to prevent food borne illness.
- Premise and health inspections of day care centers, group day care, foster care, and any Texas Department of Health and Human Resources licensed facility to protect the health and well-being of children.
- Referrals to proper agencies are made if anyone has problems or complaints that are not under the local health district's jurisdiction.
